

Place the appropriate number next to the named tool.




- 2. a metal rod or pin that has a head at one end and a screw thread at the other to take a nut
- 6. device for determining whether a surface is horizontal
- 7. hand tool for working wood with a flat steel blade cutting edge attached to a handle
- 9. frame on which wood is laid for sawing by hand
- 11. a rod-shaped metal piece with a winding groove used for fastening solid pieces together
- 12. tool used to cut hard material with a tooth-edged blade
- small square or hexagonal block with a threaded hole through the middle for screwing on the end of a bolt
- 14. tool for holding, twisting, or turning nuts and bolts
- 18. rotating tool for making circular holes
- 19. device in which a toothed rack or wheel is engaged permitting motion in one direction only

- Phillips head noun special screwdriver with the head having two partial slots crossed at right angles
- 3. chest to store tools
- 4. piece shaped like a triangle used to split wood or rocks and to lift heavy weights
- 5. small pincers with long jaws for bending wire or holding small objects
- 7. heavy iron lever with one pointed end and one forged into a wedge shape
- 8. tape marked off in units used for measuring
- 10. tool for turning screws
- 15. a straight strip marked off in units measuring
- 16. a slender piece of metal having one end pointed and the other end flattened for hammering to hold separate pieces together
- 17. tool used for driving in nails
