Course Nbr	Course Name	Course Description
BCS 101	Core Concepts of Unit Service (Updated)	The position of commissioner is one of the oldest in Scouting. This course reviews and reinforces the core concepts of unit service and identifies the key skills needed for commissioners to be able to serve their units well.
BCS 104	Connecting with Units (Updated)	The course discusses how connections commissioners make with their units are at the heart of unit service. This course looks at the role of contacts between commissioners and their units and explains the importance of using Commissioner Tools to record and manage unit contacts.
BCS 113	Welcoming, Engaging and Onboarding Commissioners	Come learn how to onboard your new commissioners.
BCS 114	Understanding & Communicating with Today's Leaders (Updated)	With a focus on Gen-Xers and Millenials, this updated course looks at the best ways to connect with these generations of adults, both as parents of youth and as volunteers in Scouting.
BCS 115	Commissioners - The Single Best Resource! (Updated)	Commissioners provide unit leadership with information and guidance on the latest changes in the programs of the BSA. Providing unit service is the same regardless of the type of unit.
BCS 119	Building Relationships (Updated)	In this course, we will discuss how commissioners can build and maintain positive relationships with those they serve and explore possible pitfalls that can undermine them.
BCS 150	Roundtables in Unit Service (Updated)	This course reviews and reinforces how roundtables fit into the unit service structure by providing roundtable services to units and unit leaders. An effective roundtable is vital to the success of all units.
BCS 154	Roundtable Fundamentals (Updated)	Roundtable is important not only for the leaders but for the youth they bring the information back to. This course extends the learning material from Roundtable Commissioner Basic Training.
MCS 307	Serving Newly Formed Units	An engaged commissioner is critical for the success and retention of new units. Commissioners designated as a new-unit commissioner focus on only new units, preferably a single unit to which they have been assigned.
MCS 310	Succession Planning (Updated)	To support the orderly change of leadership it is important to encourage each unit to create a long-term succession plan. Commissioners need to understand the process to support the development and maintenance of a succession plan in the units they support.
MCS 312	Recruiting the 21st Century Volunteer (Updated)	We know how important it is to recruit new people to our teams, but how do we bring in a new generation of volunteers to commissioning? Join this engaging discussion with some enthusiastic Scouting volunteers who are part of that new generation.
MCS 314	The Commissioner and the Professional	In this course, participants will learn more about the relationship between the commissioner and the professional and how they can work closely together to support unit success.
MCS 351	Conducting the Roundtable Planning Session	Every district and council should have an advanced roundtable plan supported by the assistant council commissioner and assistant district commissioners who focus on roundtable as unit service.
